Technical Setup

(Please share these with the folks responsible for preparing for performances and programs)

Room Setup:

- The ideal room has a wood floor, and tile is better than carpet and concrete. No posts, and no outlets or other obstacles should be sticking up on the floor.
- The room should be appropriate for the size of the group and well ventilated with a/c in the warm weather.
- One (1) six-foot table should be placed near an electrical outlet with three (3) armless chairs and one (1) easel or chalkboard set near the table.
- A power strip and if necessary, an extension cord should be available.
- If possible, a map of the world on the wall or a stand is very helpful.

Audiovisual Equipment:

- A sound system including:
 - Powered mixer (minimum 4 channels)
 - Three (3) microphones – at least one (1) head-set if possible
 - Three (3) microphone stands, microphone clips and all necessary cords and connectors
 - Two (2) separate speakers and some way to get them off the floor
- We can provide the above if the school does not have the equipment

Other suggestions:

- Many schools like to video or take digital photos of the students dancing as a record for future classes. Just be sure to send or e-mail us copies
